Winter's Last Stargazey Pie Instructions

What you will need:

4 paper plates (white)

4 washed take away lids (silver on one side) or A4 silver card/card to colour in Templates print out 1 x Herring and 1 x Compass Star

Paper scissors (ask for help cutting out if you need it)

Glue stick

Pencil or hole punch for eyes

Felt pens to colour in the pie pastry

Newspaper to protect your table

Instructions:

Cut out 8 fish and glue to back side (non silver side) of take away lids or card Score the fishtails with a biro or a fork and curl up 4 heads and 4 tails Punch out eyes with a hole-punch or from the silver side with a pencil point Colour in underside of the rim i.e. 'the crust' of paper plate 1 add brown edge Cut the rim i.e. 'the crust' off plate 2 and colour the base of paper plate 2 Fold the base of paper plate 2 in half and in half again then cut a 2cm slit in each fold 2cm from the edge to form openings for 4 fish-head Open out the base and slip 4 fish-heads through the slits and glue tails together

Stick the remaining 4 fish tails onto plate 1 so they stick out over the piecrust Glue the compass star and lettering glue to the back of a paper plate 3 and cut out

Colour in back of the cut out compass star and NSWE lettering and glue to top of paper plate 2

Glue paper plate 2 on top of paper plate 1 to create your pastry top Glue paper plates 1&2 to paper plate 4 as your dish to create your 3D pie!
